Topic: "Orchids 101"

## President's Message:


#### Happy April!



## ORCHID TIDBITS

#### Tips for New Orchid Growers

- 1. Start accumulating different books about how to grow Orchids. Remember we have a library at your disposal every meeting to check out.
- 2. Check on your plants frequently
- 3. Keep an eye out for signs of pests and disease (Don't forget to look UNDER the foliage).
- 4. Do not over water your plants
- 5. Do not over crowd your collection
- 6. Keep some type of record keeping on your orchids. Name of plant and when you acquired it, when it flowered etc.

#### ARE YOUR LEAVES TURNING YELLOW AND FALLING OFF?????

- \* First lets make sure that these leaves are not the oldest leaves on your plant. Due to the normal growth cycle the oldest leaves will yellow and fall off.
- \* BUT—if your young leaves are YELLOWING and DROPPING off you may actually have an issue. Your leaves may turn yellow due to a lack of light, and or fertilizer.
