Topic: Warm Growing Brazilian Miltonias
Speaker: Brian Monk

Brian Monk born in Milton, Florida developed an intense passion for nature while growing up in Charleston, West Virginia which led to his profession as a veterinarian and his many hobbies including bird-watching, orchid growing, photography and natural history. Because of his passion for all things orchid, Brian and his wife, Mary-Margaret, formed Blu Llama Orchids, Inc. and now reside in Ft. Lauderdale along with their five cats and their ever expanding orchid collection.

Brian started growing and hybridizing orchids in his backyard, but this has recently expanded to a 4000 square foot greenhouse. He will grow anything green, but focuses on his hybridizing projects, which include the development of multi-floral white and pink Paphiopedilums, warmth-tolerant red Oncidiinae and a standard pink Cattleya with an all white lip.

Encouraged by his wife and inspired by his orchids, Brian continues to pursue and perfect his orchid culture and photographic skills. Brian's photography has won awards online, at the 2007 Miami International Orchid Show and at the 2008 World Orchid Conference.

Brian will be bringing plants to sell and will be providing our raffle table.

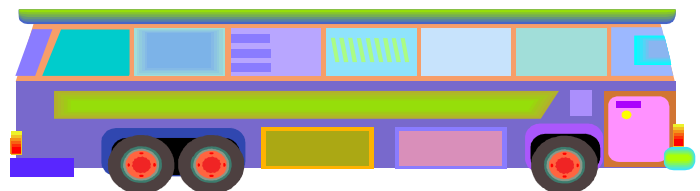

ORCHID TIDBITS

Tips on how to repot your orchids or New Orchid Growers

You want to start accumulating different books about how to grow Orchids. Remember we have a library at your disposal every meeting for you to check out.

1. Wash your hands and make sure that you use sterilize all of your tools before you start
2. Remove your Orchid from its pot by turning it over (over top of a garbage can) while supporting the plant and gently taping on the pot to loosen the plant. You can also use a sterilized knife to lightly scrape around the inside of the pot.
3. Gently remove the old potting material with your hands.
4. If you see old or loose roots remove them by cutting them with a sterilized tool.
5. Place the Orchid in a pot one size bigger than the pot it was just in. Remember to place the old growth towards the back of the pot leaving room at the front for the new growth to grow.
6. If your roots were damaged or diseased and need to be removed then plant the Orchid in a sterilized pot the same size.
7. You can fill the bottom of your pot with a layer of Styrofoam peanuts to ensure proper drainage and now add fresh potting medium.
8. Make sure that you pack the potting medium around your plants roots to ensure that it is secure.
